WALKING: Just nine miles by five with a range of varied terrain, it's easy to explore Jersey on foot. From coastlines carpeted with gorse and wildflowers, to peaceful wooded valleys, quiet tree-lined lanes, reservoir walks and rugged beach trails, a walking holiday in Jersey opens up the island for you to discover. FOOD: Although a small island Jersey is famous for its food. The Island is bursting with flavour from abundant local produce and rich creamy milk to seafood straight from the island's clear waters.
