# Furnas & Lagoa Do Fogo Lakes

This morning head south towards the valley of Furnas. En-route stop at the view point at Pisão at Água de Pau village, which overlooks the sea and the small village of Caloura, before continuing to Vila Franca Do Campo, the first capital of the island. Because of its thermal springs, Furnas Valley is considered one of the biggest hydropolis in the world. Visit the Furnas lagoon nearby and taste the traditional cozido. Using the volcanic heat, the Azoreans cook meat and vegetables in a large pot buried in the ground for several hours. After lunch visit the botanical garden, see the many geysers and mineral water springs and perhaps bathe in a natural hot water swimming pool.

Remember to bring your bathing costume (an old one preferably as the water can turn it brown) and towel! Visit a tea plantation for a tasting and see the old machinery used for processing the tea. Travelling via the mountain road reach Lagoa do Fogo (Fire Lake), a lake in the interior of a crater of an extinct volcano and the highest point above sea level on Sao Miguel Island. Transfer

back to Ponta Delgada and overnight there.

# Full Day Sete Cidades with Lunch

Today explore the valley of Sete Cidades, the most popular national park in the islands, composed of two lakes in the centre of a volcanic crater measuring about three miles across. Enjoy a leisurely walk along the lake shore or relax in a local café. Stop for a buffet lunch at a typical Azorean restaurant and in the afternoon visit the Ethnographical Museum in Capelas, before continuing to Faja de Baixo to visit a plantation, which grows pineapples in hothouses. Transfer back to Ponta Delgada for the night.

After lunch continue towards Angra do Heroísmo, nominated by UNESCO as a World Heritage town. Continue towards Angra do Heroísmo with a stop at the viewpoint of Pico das Cruzinhas in Monte Brasil. # Afternoon Tour of Angra do Heroísmo

Arrive at Lajes airport and meet your local guide. Transfer to the hotel to drop off luggage. Free time for lunch (not included). After lunch depart on foot from the meeting point to enjoy a walking tour of Angra do Heroísmo, a UNESCO World Heritage city. Visit the main church of Se Cathedral and the City Museum before a stroll through the shopping district and botanical garden. End the tour tasting some delicious local calorie-laden pastries. The remainder of the afternoon is free to explore further, relax on the city beach or back at the hotel.

DAY 6 FRIDAY 10th July 2026

You will be collected from your hotel and transferred to the airport for your onward flight. Pick up time confirmed locally.



### Afternoon Tour of Pico's northern shore

Today transfer to the airport for the short flight to Pico Island, also known as the Grey Island and the second largest island in the Azores Archipelago. In the afternoon explore the northern part of the island. Drive through the UNESCO World Heritage site with its distinctive vineyards to the village of São Roque and visit the old whale factory here. On the return to Madalena visit the Centro de Interpretação da Paisagem da Cultura da Vinha da Ilha do Pico and learn all about the history of wine–making on Pico. Stop off at the location called "Cachorro", a small ocean side village where the ocean waters flow in and out of the century old lava tunnels and formations, creating unforgettable sounds and colours.

# Full Day Pico Island

This morning depart to the picturesque fishing village of Lajes do Pico for a talk on marine conservation before embarking on an exciting whale watching tour. More than 20 species of cetacean inhabit the waters surrounding Pico or pass by on their migratory routes. Enjoy lunch in the village before exploring the rest of Pico, drive along the islands interior roads, we will travel to an altitude of 900 meters above sea level where you will see various endemic species of fauna and flora and appreciate the contrast between the lush green pastures and the black lava formation that is the majestic mountain of Pico at an altitude of 2351 meters above sea level. Visit the important church of São Mateus with its magnificent interior décor. Enjoy a walking tour of the small main town of Madalena.

Madalena - Horta, Class: Shared

Board the ferry for the four mile boat crossing to the island of Faial, which takes approximately 30 minutes.



You will be met at the port and transferred to your hotel.

On arrival check-in at your hotel (depending on whether rooms are available for early check-in) in Horta, the island's lively capital and arguably the most eye-catching town in the Azores. It is a haven for yachtsmen and whale watchers, filled with colourful yachts which stop here during voyages across the North Atlantic. The afternoon is at leisure.

# Full Day Faial Island Tour

Awake in Horta and start a full day tour of Faial, also known as the Blue Island. Faial was the last location of major volcanic activity in the Azores, when Capelinhos erupted in 1957, adding 1km of land to the island. This area, resembling the surface of the moon, is in stark contrast to the hydrangea-lined roads of the rest of the island. After lunch, pass by Caldeira, the highest point on the island, and on the way to Horta stop in the Espalamaca for a view over Horta. Stop at a typical cheese factory – the Azoreans are very proud of their dairy so a tasting session here is a must. The cows in the Azores certainly have enough to eat with its lush green pastures and temperate climate, they are kept outside all year.
