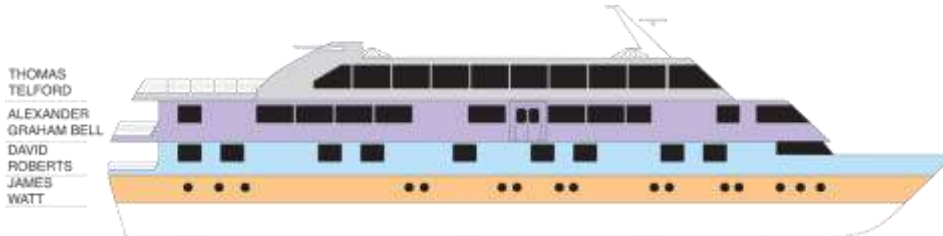

ELEGANT CABINS Arranged across three decks, with all cabins outward-facing for you to enjoy the views. 23 cabins have large picture windows (with tinted glass for extra privacy) and two cabins offer double portholes. All cabins boasts en-suite shower, toilet, and washbasin & tantalise your senses with Highland Soap Company natural toiletries in eco-friendly, refillable dispensers. There is ample wardrobe space, bedside drawers, a dressing table, a safe for valuables, hairdryer, satellite TV and internal telephone.



Each deck is named after famous Scots:

THOMAS TELFORD DECK Thomas Telford regarded as one of Scotland's finest ever engineers and built many of the roads and bridges that you may see on your Scottish travels. The Thomas Telford Deck hosts the Sir Walter Scott Lounge and Bar as well as the David Livingstone Lounge and Library. There are two viewing terraces forward & aft.

ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL DECK When telephoning the other side of the world, you have Alexander Graham Bell to thank, as this Scottish entrepreneur invented the telephone in 1876. The Alexander Graham Bell Deck hosts the reception area and the Robert Louis Stevenson Restaurant.

CATEGORY 3 CABINS ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL DECK £3650

6 twin bedded superior cabins situated on the Alexander Graham Bell Deck. All have picture windows to enjoy Scotland's beautiful scenery.

DAVID ROBERTS DECK Well-known Scottish painter, David Roberts, lends his name to this deck. Famous for work such as The Houses of Parliament from Millbank and the travelogue, The Holy Land, Syria, Idumea, Arabia, Egypt, and Nubia. Some of his lithographs are present on *Lord of the Glens*.

CATEGORY 2 CABINS DAVID ROBERTS DECK £3200 TWIN £4940 SOLO

4 twin bedded cabins & 4 double bedded cabins all having picture windows.

CATEGORY 3 CABINS DAVID ROBERTS DECK £3650 TWIN £6700 SOLO

8 twin bedded superior cabins on the David Roberts Deck. These cabins are the largest on the ship and all have large picture windows.

JAMES WATT DECK The James Watt Deck is named after the illustrious Scottish engineer and inventor whose work with steam engines brought about huge change to the world during the industrial revolution. Cabins on this deck have portholes, which add to the seafaring experience.

CATEGORY 1 CABIN JAMES WATT DECK £2750 TWIN £4220 SOLO

These cabins are located on the James Watt Deck which is two decks below the reception level. Each cabin has twin beds and two large portholes.
