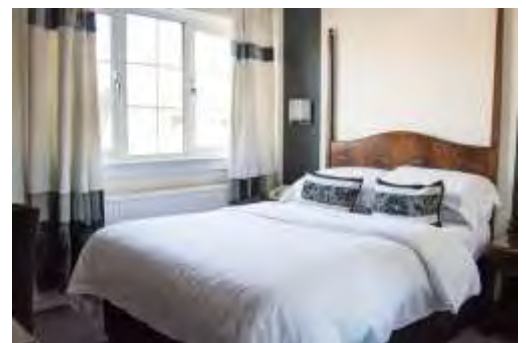
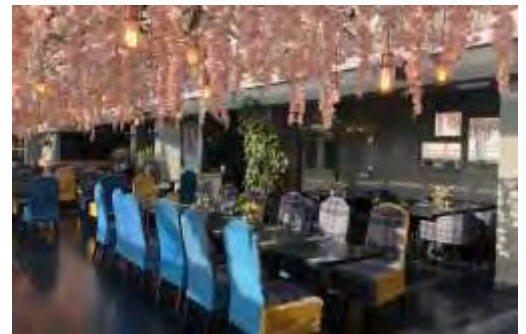

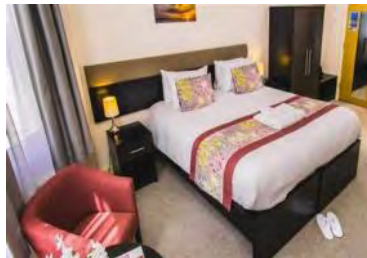

17 November – transferred to Heathrow and fly to South Africa

You will be picked up and transferred to London Heathrow for your overnight flight to Johannesburg.

18 November – Arrival

Meet your guide at the airport for the transfer to Mabula Game Lodge. Upon arrival at the lodge, unwind and settle in, perhaps making use of the wellness and spa facilities.

This evening, **dinner** is served at the lodge, as you enjoy a first night under the starry African sky, looking forward to a wonderful break ahead.

19 November – Safari and wildlife talk

Rise and shine early this morning, grab a tea or coffee and perhaps some rusks then head out into the Mabula Private Game Reserve on **the first of many wonderful safaris**. All safari drives are in open-air 4x4 vehicles for maximum visibility. Keep your eyes open for the fabled Big Five, hyena, jackal, antelope, the elusive cheetah and adorable honey badger. Upon your return to the lodge, enjoy a well-earned, leisurely **breakfast**.

This afternoon, you'll enjoy a fascinating **wildlife talk**. Delivered by the resident ecologist and reserve manager, the talk will introduce you to some of the 60 mammals and the 300-plus species of birds and reptiles that inhabit the reserve, arming you with some interesting knowledge for forthcoming week.

This evening, after your first full day in your wonderful new surroundings, enjoy **dinner** at the lodge.

20 November – Hornbill Project and safari

This morning you'll visit the **Hornbill Project**, located within the boundaries of the reserve. Founded in 1999, the award-winning Hornbill Project aims to change the fortunes of this iconic, endangered species through a number of different evidence-based conservation techniques. The southern hornbill is a focal point in South African culture, and you'll learn all about them this morning.

This afternoon, you'll head out into the reserve on a **safari**, equipped with the knowledge from this morning's visit and yesterday's wildlife talk, before **dinner** is served **under the stars** at the lodge this evening.

21 November – Morning safari

Rise and shine early this morning for an **included morning safari**, giving you the chance to spot herds of antelopes and other deer moving in the open as they tend to move around more early in the day, to find the best protection from predators.

Return to the lodge and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, perhaps making use of the wellness and spa facilities or the leisure area, including tennis and cricket, before **dinner** is served at the lodge this evening.

22 November – Bush walk, safari and sundowner

After **breakfast**, join your guide for a **gentle guided bush walk** into the reserve. Enjoying the fresh air as you stretch your legs, giving you a different more intimate perspective of the reserve. Being closer to the ground also allows you to track the paths of animals including kudu, zebra and maybe even lions that have followed the same path just a few hours before you.

This afternoon, embark on another open-air **safari** into the reserve, keeping your eyes open for the Big Five. After the safari, you'll stop at a picturesque spot to enjoy a refreshing **sundowner** and some snacks as the sun slips behind the horizon and the sky turns a vibrant patchwork of red, purple, orange and yellow – a fitting end to a wonderful day.

23 November – Safari and stargazing

Rise and shine early this morning as you head out into the reserve on your **penultimate safari**, hopefully spotting something new to tick off your list.

Enjoy a leisurely **breakfast** at the lodge upon your return.

This evening, you'll spend an unforgettable night **stargazing**. As the sun goes down, thousands of twinkling stars, including the Milky Way, reveal themselves to you, completely free of any light pollution. Your guide will point out the different constellations visible as you spend a wonderful evening beneath the **starry South African night sky**, topped off by **dinner** at the lodge.

24 November – Safari and bush lunch

Today, your last full day at the lodge, brings the chance to take one **last safari** out into the Mabula Private Game Reserve, giving you a final opportunity to tick animals off your list. Enjoy a leisurely **breakfast** and morning before setting off into the reserve.

After the safari you'll stop at a scenic spot in the bush to enjoy a delicious **traditional lunch** – a fitting finale to an exceptional week on safari.

25 November – Departure

After **breakfast**, it's time to say your goodbyes to the lodge and its staff. You'll be transferred to Johannesburg airport for your overnight return flight bringing a wonderful week to an end.

What an exhilarating adventure to start the year, 350km above the Arctic Circle. Stunning winter landscapes and the cleanest crispest air in the world giving the best possible opportunity to see the Northern Lights.

Departing Humberside airport on a dedicated charter flight, we flew 3 hours direct to Enontiokeo. This 5 day holiday is very inclusive, I only spent 10 Euros although many guests did bring home souvenirs unique to the area.

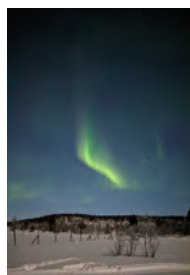
This is an action packed break ticking off those bucket list must do's. Not only did we enjoy thrilling times we also learn't about the history and culture of the area and how the small communities survive.



Our first activity was to a Reindeer camp and a sleigh safari. Following a talk about the reindeer and way of life we climbed aboard our sleighs and were ready for off. I was alone in the first sleigh and spent the whole time laughing but did get a little scared when the reindeer behind almost joined me in my sleigh! We then enjoyed taking the reins for our own sleigh ride around a small circuit totally in control.

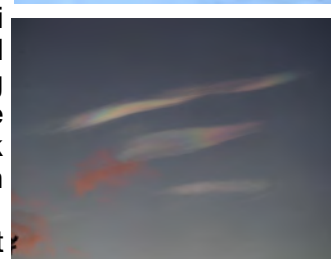


A big wow for me was mushing my own sled with 5 Alaskan Huskies. The howling and excitement of the dogs before we set off was piercing to the ear drums but once on our way they were happy. 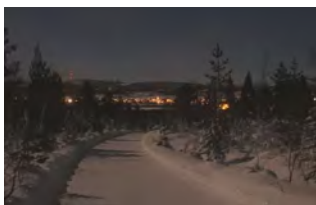


For many the highlight was the Northern Lights Snowmobile safari where in the dark of night we wended our way through the forest and out into the middle of a frozen lake and watched the lights dancing around. Truly magical, a fantastic sight to see in the dark skies of the wilderness. For those without a driving license or wishing to sit back and not worry about controlling the machine you could ride in a sleigh behind our guide.

We also had a treat during the day of the Mother of Peel Clouds not often seen.



The next day we trekked through the deep snow in the forest wearing snow shoes. Our introduction to this sport allowed us to pad gently through the peaceful forest spotting tracks left by the Arctic hare.



Two nights of the holiday we walked up Davvi Hill in search of the lights and they did come, for those not wanting to have extra exercise the lights were visible just outside the hotel as shown in the top photo above the cabins. From the hill we had a lovely view of the Swedish part of the town as shown in the photo. The river acts as the border between both countries. There is a bigger population in Sweden and only 100 inhabitants on the Finnish side of town.

All food is included breakfast, lunch, dinner plus late night soup. It is very hearty fare offering something for everyone to enjoy, no one would be hungry and you could just help yourself to as much as you wanted.

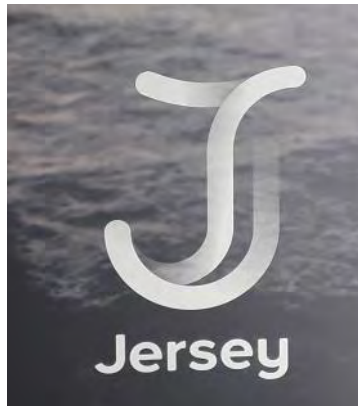
